★ **DEBBIE HARRY** (Fridays, Saturdays, and Tuesdays through Thursdays, through April 4) In the 1970s, when Ms. Harry and her band Blondie first trod CBGB's sticky boards, she was the prototype of the glamorous punk: a woman full of righteous conviction who also radiated poise. Now, one year after the band celebrated its 40th anniversary and released the album "Ghosts of Download," she takes to the regal Café Carlyle on the Upper East Side for a short residency. It's a long way from the East Village, but a fitting place for a rock eminence.
