A Radiohead Tribute At Café Carlyle

A “Hedwig and the Angry
Inch” reunion of sorts will arrive



at Café Carlyle this month, set to the music of . . . Radiohead.

Lena Hall, left, and Michael C. Hall, right, who appeared opposite each other in “Hedwig” in 2014-15, will perform a tribute, “Radiohead: Obsessed,” on March 19. The duo (who are not related) will perform songs from the band’s early days, when it originated with the 1992 single “Creep,” to its latest album, “The King of Limbs,” released in 2011.

Ms. Hall, a Tony Award winner, performed at the Carlyle last spring, and has made Radiohead’s “Karma Police” part of her recent repertoire. Mr. Hall recently played the lead in the musical “Lazarus,” one of David Bowie’s last projects.
