John Pizzarelli with Daniel Jobim

Brazilian music brings out the poet in the guitarist and vocalist Pizzarelli. Lighting on classic bossa nova, with assistance from the singer Jobim (the grandson of the Brazilian great Antonio Carlos Jobim), Pizzarelli basks in a tropical comfort zone that is as inspiring to him as the work of Sondheim or Ellington. In honor of Frank Sinatra's centennial, Pizzarelli is also likely to invoke the late-sixties collaborations between Ol' Blue Eyes and Jobim.
