Some of Broadway's biggest names opt for more intimate affairs

Over at the Café Carlyle, singer **Steve Tyrell's** 11th annual holiday engagement will salute the Frank Sinatra centennial with *One More for the Road*—it was with a Sinatra-like rendition of “The Way You Look Tonight,” in the 1991 remake of *Father of the Bride* that record producer Tyrell instantly established himself as a saloon singer. Tyrell will be in Dec. 1–Jan. 2, backed by music director **Quinn Johnson**—and the Carlyle just about bursts with swing when Tyrell croons, backed by six pieces, in the musical jewel-box on Madison Avenue.
